## LIEUTENANT COLONEL JAIME M. ANDERSON, USAFR

Lieutenant Colonel Jaime Anderson is an Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA) assigned to the Directorate of Strategy, Plans, and Programs, HQ Pacific Air Forces (PACAF), Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii, as a strategic planner responsible to COMPACAF, PACAF/A5/8 for strategy and plans in INDOPACOM AOR. She supports the branch responsible for air, space, and cyber power strategy development & integration across the combatant command and HQ Air Force.

Lieutenant Colonel Anderson has served in a variety of Joint and USAF assignments at base, COCOM, and HAF levels. Prior to her current assignment, Lieutenant Colonel Anderson served in the Office of the Secretary of the Air Force and the Chief of Staff of the Air Force, Headquarters Air Force (HAF), Pentagon, Washington D.C., as Chief of Reserve Affairs in the SecAF/CSAF Executive Action Group (EAG). As the total force integration expert on a selectively manned 21-person team, she directly supported the Top Five (SecAF,



CSAF, USecAF, VCSAF and CVA) by preparing speeches, briefings, remarks and articles for key senior leader engagements with Congress, DoD, the Joint Staff, and industry leaders.

As a member of the Reserve team assigned to the United States Delegation to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Military Committee (USDELMC), Brussels, Belgium, she directly supported the USMILREP (O-9) and the US Ambassador to NATO during joint planning and crisis management team operations and exercises.

While assigned to the Exercise Directorate, HQ USPACOM/J7, she served as the primary action officer for the Joint Task Force Training and Certification program and was the primary JECG Operations Officer for multiple Tier I, II and III SOCPAC and PACOM exercises. She has produced numerous Asia-Pacific country primers, open-source intelligence briefings and exercise plans and programs for the USPACOM Commander and senior leadership.

As the Joint Military Personnel Officer at the Defense Supply Center Columbus (DSCC), in Columbus, Ohio, Lieutenant Colonel Anderson trained, equipped, and deployed Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine personnel (active duty and reserve), along with civil servants, to multiple overseas locations in support of operations IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM and JOINT GUARDIAN. She also provided a broad range of military personnel support to all guard, reserve, active duty and retired service members in the greater Columbus, Ohio area.

Lieutenant Colonel Anderson began her Air Force career as the Chief of Relocations, Employment and Readiness, by providing deployment and assignment support to the students, pilots, and non-rated active-duty members stationed at Columbus AFB, Mississippi. She graduated from the United States Air Force Academy in 1998, completed Squadron Officer School by correspondence in 2003, earned her Master of Arts in Education (MAEd) in 2005, and completed Air Command and Staff College in 2009.
